Shelter in place kit inventory: □ 5-gallon bucket with trash bags and kitty litter - You can pack most of the items in the 5-gallon bucket and it will double as a toilet by lining it with a trash bag and pouring about an inch of kitty litter in the bottom. □ 1 gallon of water per person for 3 days - A case of bottled water is just over 3 gallons. □ 3 days of non-perishable food per person - 1 package of S.O.S. emergency food rations is enough food for 1 person for 3 days. ☐ Household chlorine bleach (unscented with no additives) - You can add 16 drops per gallon of water to disinfect it or mix 1 part bleach to 9 parts water to make a cleaner. ☐ Battery-powered or hand-crank NOAA weather radio ☐ Flashlight with extra batteries ☐ First aid kit □ N95 dust mask per person to help filter contaminated air Plastic sheeting and duct tape to seal - Enough to seal all doors, windows, and vents in the shelter in place room. ☐ Baby wipes and garbage bags - For cleaning yourself and disposing of waste. ☐ Whistle to signal for help ☐ Wrench or pliers to shut off utilities ☐ Fire extinguisher Additional items to add if your situation requires them: □ Diapers and formula if you need to shelter with an infant ☐ Food and water for pets ☐ Can opener if you pack canned food ☐ Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children ☐ Sleeping bags or extra bedding for comfort or in cold environments ☐ Mess kits, paper cups, plates and plastic utensils, paper towels
